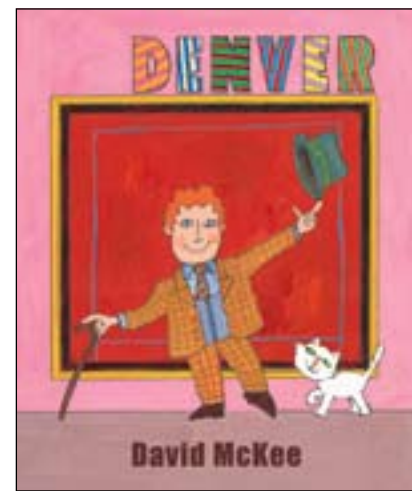
DENVER
