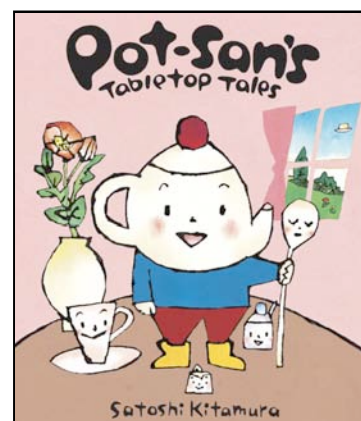
Taking a modern translation of the original full-length text, Fulvio Testa has created 58 stunning paintings and produced a child-friendly classic to adorn any collector's shelf.
