

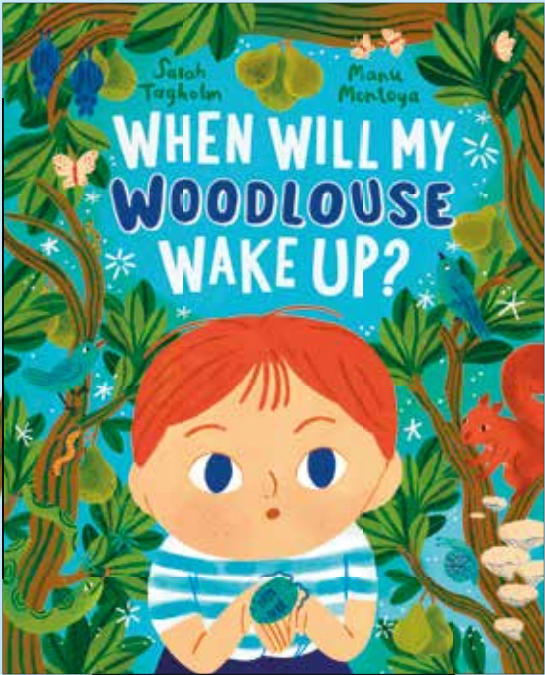

WHEN WILL MY WOODLOUSE WAKE UP?

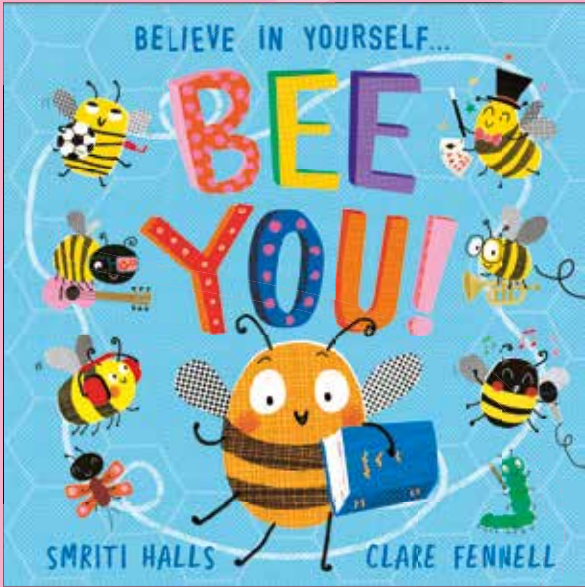
