

From former **Birmingham Young Poet Laureate** Nyanda Foday, comes this inspirational poem about the vital need for every child to see themselves in the books they read.




Learn to live in the moment and see the beauty around you with Ava and her adventuring parents.

Meet your animal alter-egos in this picture book about dealing with complex emotions – and recognising the effect our behaviour can have on others.


