




THE BOX FULL OF WONDERS


This touching story captures both the struggles and possibilities of blended families. The power of one child's imagination is beautifully visualised on the pages as he begins to embrace his new siblings.

Will the twins find each other and escape, or will they both be stuck as Roman slaves for ever?


