

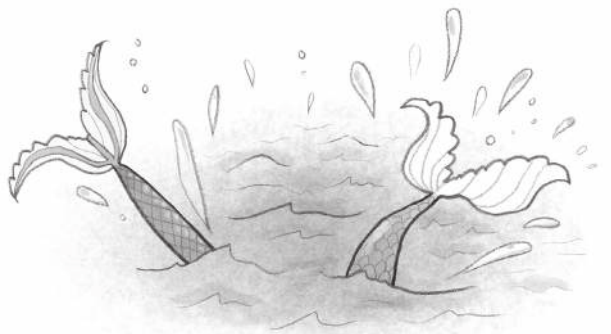
MERMAID SCHOOL

- ★ Read pages 39-40 of *Mermaid School*, about Marnie's mum making dinner, to give you some ideas.



Top story writing tips:

- 🕒 Plan what will happen at the beginning of the story, some exciting action for the middle, and an ending to tie it all together
- 🕒 Use words like 'First', 'Then', 'Next', 'However' and 'Finally' to move your story along
- 🕒 Describe things so that readers can imagine what's happening – think about what the characters can see, hear, taste and smell
- 🕒 Draw some pictures to help tell your story
- 🕒 Think of a fun title for your story
